Sculpture Walk Map

JIM & SUE HEEMSTRA

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1. **PINNACLE** by Jim Heemstra
From its distinctively sculptured cone-like base up to its culmination, observe the artist's journey in the thousands of decisions made along the way.

2. GREENWOOD by Jim Heemstra
Go up close to the sculpture (but don't touch) and observe the colorfully painted forms and features on it. Also look for the colorful forms and features of the prairie wildflowers like spiderwort, coneflower, butterfly weed, aster, or whatever is in season.

3. RED FLAG by Sue Heemstra

Look closer at the sculpture to find some figurative forms on this red piece that complements the green landscape. You may also want to look and listen for the swallows darting around the birdhouses on the other side of the trail.

4. RAINFOREST by Sue Heemstra

Feel the wind and view the prairie landscape noting how it differs from an actual dark and wet rainforest that inspired the color of the glaze on this ceramic sculpture. Now there's a big hill to climb to get to number five, but keep on going.

5. PABLO by Sue Heemstra
If this sculpture had real eyes, it would be privileged to a magnificent view every day. Look at the posts to your right by the pasture gate. This is where you can make your own “Declaration” of who you are, where you are, and what you are today.
